

According to hydrogen content grapes grown in Uzbekistan are considered to be the sweetest ones among other winegrowing areas of the world.




EXPORT POTENTIAL OF FRUITS AND VEGETABLES


There is a great demand in foreign markets for fruits and vegetables grown in Uzbekistan, especially for:

- and many other types of fruits and vegetables.


DYNAMICS OF EXPORT OF THE MAIN TYPES OF FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, 2003-2013




DYNAMICS OF EXPORT OF THE MAIN TYPES OF FRESH FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, 2000-2013




DYNAMICS OF EXPORT OF THE MAIN TYPES OF DRIED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES, 2000-2013

TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE AND NETWORK DEVELOPMENT

The Government of Uzbekistan in cooperation with Korean Air established International intermodal logistic center at Navoi Airport. The center is used as transcontinental transport-forwarding hub, linking Eastern and Sothern Eastern Asia with Europe, Middle East and the CIS.





Navoi air harbor is cooperating with major logistics centers of Eurasia, including Incheon, Milan, Brussels, Istanbul, Dubai, New Delhi and Tianjin.

In near future, Uzbekistan is planning to increase capacities of international multimodal center of logistics on the base of Navoi airport from 100 to 300,000 thousand tons of cargo a year.




LEGISLATIVE BASE: PRIVILEGES AND PREFERENCES TO EXPORTERS

The current legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan provides a number of privileges and preferences to exporters

«On additional measures to strengthen the incentives for companies exporting and expanding exports of competitive products».



SPECIALIZED EXPORT PROMOTION ORGANIZATIONS

Specialized Foreign Trade Company «UZTADBIRKOREKSPORT» was established by presidential decree No UP-4354, dated August 24, 2011 "On additional measures to achieve the most favorable business environment for further development of small and private business."

In accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan №122, dated April 28, 2011, the Bureau of Export Promotion under the Agency of "Uzstandard" was established.

FUND FOR SUPPORT OF EXPORT OF SMALL BUSINESSES AND PRIVATE ENTREPRENEURSHIP In accordance with the Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No PP-2022, dated August 8, 2013 "On additional measures on support of exports of small businesses and private entrepreneurship", the fund for support of export of small businesses and private entrepreneurship was established under the National Bank for Foreign Economic Activity of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

MEASURES FOR FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF SEED FARMING AND WINEGROWING

- creation of new highly fruitful and competitive crop varieties, appropriate to soil and climatic conditions of the regions;
- development of intensive gardening;
- introduction of modern farming methods into agricultural production;
- small tractors and agricultural machinery manufacturing for the needs of producers of fruit, vegetables and grapes.

International fair and exhibition of mini-technologies for agriculture "Uzbekistan Agrominitech Expo" has been held since 2006 in the pavilions of "Uzexpocentre" NEC OJSS.

More than 220 companies from 30 countries of the world, including from Europe, Israel, South Korea, China, Turkey and other countries participated during successful holding of exhibition sales in 2006-2013.

Exhibitions were visited by more than 32 thousand representatives of small business, agro industrial firms and farms. As a result, more than 2000 contracts for delivery of the modern equipment worth 70 mln. dollars have been signed and realized.
